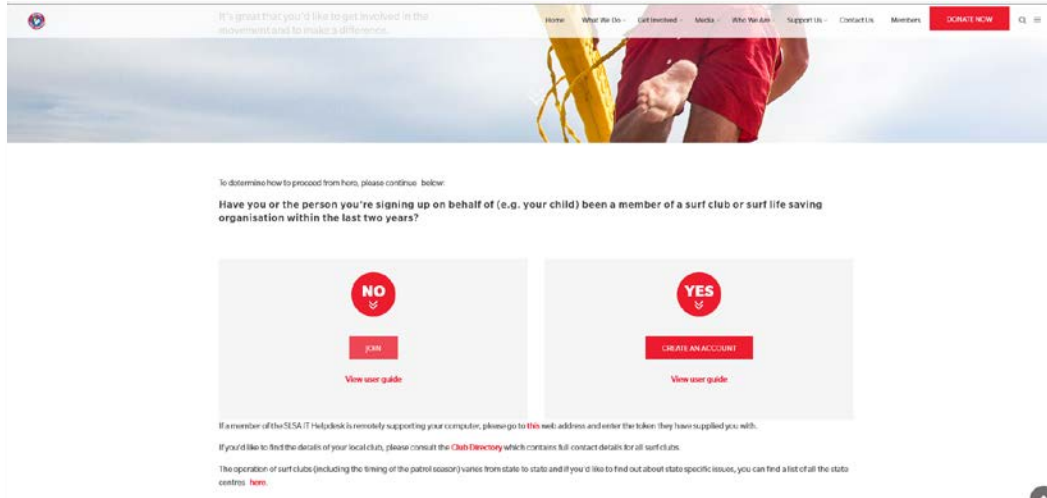

NIPPERS SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

Children MUST have turned 5 years of age before they can join our program.

Proof of age/birth certificate must be shown for all new children joining a Surf Club or for any child that has not produced a birth certificate. Please join online then attend one of our registration days with proof of age documents.

Evaluation of the Preliminary Skills Evaluation Test			Surf Education Awards
U6	In shallow water, from a standing position perform a front glide and recover to a secure position. Perform a back or front float using buoyancy aid and recover to a secure position.		Surf Play 1
U7	In shallow water, from a standing position perform a front glide, kick for 3m then recover to a secure position. Perform a back or front float for a few seconds and recover to a secure position.		Surf Play 2
U8	25 metre swim (any stroke)	1 min survival float	Surf Aware 1
U9	25 metre swim (any stroke)	1 min survival float	Surf Aware 2
U10	25 metre swim (freestyle)	1.5 min survival float	Surf Safe 1
U11	50 metre swim (freestyle)	2 min survival float	Surf Safe 2
U12	100 metre swim (freestyle)	2 min survival float	Surf Smart 1
U13	150 metre swim (freestyle)	3 min survival float	Surf Smart 2
U14	200 metre swim (freestyle) In less than 5 min	3 min survival float	Surf Rescue Certificate (SRC)
<i>Notes</i>	All active nipper junior members must participate in this evaluation prior to any junior water activity training or competition being undertaken. Members that don't meet the required evaluation level will require a higher level of supervision when involved in water based activities at the discretion of SMSLC.	The competition evaluation done at the beach must be achieved before any junior members are eligible to compete.	Every active nipper should achieve the relevant Surf Education Award appropriate to their age group.
