



## Code of Conduct

### **Introduction**

This Code of Conduct shall be read in conjunction with the Constitution of the Kiama Downs Surf Life Saving Club Inc and Surf Life Saving Australia Member Protection Policy – SLSA 6.05.

### **Purpose**

To ensure values of our Club drive behaviour and conduct of all members and align with the expectations and values of Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA)

### **Responsibility**

The Codes must be followed at all times and by all Members and all people involved in any way with Surf Life Saving.

### **Procedure**

All members, supporters and associates of the Club are to abide by the SLSA Code of Conduct and recognise that they have a responsibility to a duty of care to all SLSA members at all times. The Codes of Conduct are contained in the Surf Life Saving Australia Member Protection Policy – SLSA 6.05 (Section 3.5)

SLSA General Code of Conduct;

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others
- Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others, and be a positive role model
- Make a commitment to providing quality service
- Be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adherence to SLSA's standards, rules, regulations and policies
- Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age
- Contribute to the provision of a safe environment to the conduct of all activities within surf lifesaving.

Surf Life Saving Team Leaders, Team Managers, Age Managers, Coaches, Officials, Athletes, Administrators/Directors/Officers and Parents/Guardians are also bound by additional Codes of Conduct depending on their roles within the organisation.

### **Conclusion**

The above Code of Conduct will ensure all members drive behaviours and conduct in line with the values of Surf Life Saving.
